Your child has been identified and selected based on multiple literacy screening assessments and classroom teacher recommendations to receive a daily extended learning opportunity to support his/her literacy development called Leveled Literacy Intervention (LLI). I, a certified reading specialist, will work with your child to build the skills and strategies that are needed to become a good reader. Our goal is to help your child learn independently in his/her classroom.

The Fountas & Pinnell Leveled Literacy Intervention System (LLI) is a small group, supplementary literacy intervention designed to help teachers provide additional support to students in the area of literacy development. The lessons are designed around engaging leveled books, which support both reading and writing to help students expand their knowledge of language and words and how they work. The goal of LLI is to bring students to grade level achievement in reading.

Throughout the program, your child will be receiving tasks to complete at home. Practicing reading at home every day has a powerful impact on a child's reading success in school. I will continue to communicate updates on your child's progress on a frequent basis.

In addition to reading at home, it is most important that your child comes to school each day. LLI lessons are part of a student's daily routine, so it is important for your child to be to school on time and alert to learn at school each day.
